Highlighting India's export momentum and ambitious goals, **Dr. Ajay Sahai, Director General and CEO, Federation of Indian Export Organizations (FIEO) said,** "India is poised for significant export growth, with a target of \$2 trillion by 2030. In recent years, our exports have surged from \$478 billion to \$778 billion, demonstrating a robust compound annual growth rate of over 8%. To sustain this momentum, we aim for a 14% CAGR, which is achievable given the supportive ecosystem and India's technological prowess. Key sectors such as machinery, hand tools, automobiles, electronics, and medical equipment are outperforming global import growth rates. India's strategic initiatives, including the Production Linked Incentive Scheme and the focus on R&D, are further bolstering these sectors. The global shift towards 'China Plus One' policies and the potential realignment of global value chains present significant opportunities for India. We are actively pursuing free trade agreements with key markets like the UAE, Australia, UK, Oman, Peru, and the EU to enhance our export competitiveness. While challenges remain, India's strong fundamentals,



coupled with government support and industry innovation, position us as a global manufacturing and export hub."
